

Instruction for the authorisation of DFDS

Some important hints in advance:


- ✓ Please, first check the system requirements, shown on our website. When the condition is not fully satisfied, Doka cannot guarantee for smooth ability and functionality. Caution: The system requirements of each program module are different!
- ✓ The "DokaCAD" installations require an already existing and appropriate CAD software installation.
- ✓ Each program module must be registered separately!
- ✓ The authorization code is only valid for the computer and the program module, from where the registration has done!

Authorisation process:

1.)

Call the requested program (Tipos, Beam statics, ...).

Close the website now. Afterwards close the dialogue "Enter authorisation code" with „Cancel“. Now the program runs still as demo version! This dialogue will still be displayed when starting the program again, until a valid authorization code is entered.

5.)

Within the next working days you will get an e-mail with the authorisation code for the requested module, which you must enter in the dialogue mentioned in point 1.). We recommend entering the authorisation code with Copy / Paste, to avoid type errors.

Then the program is fully usable!
